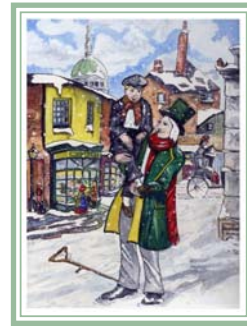

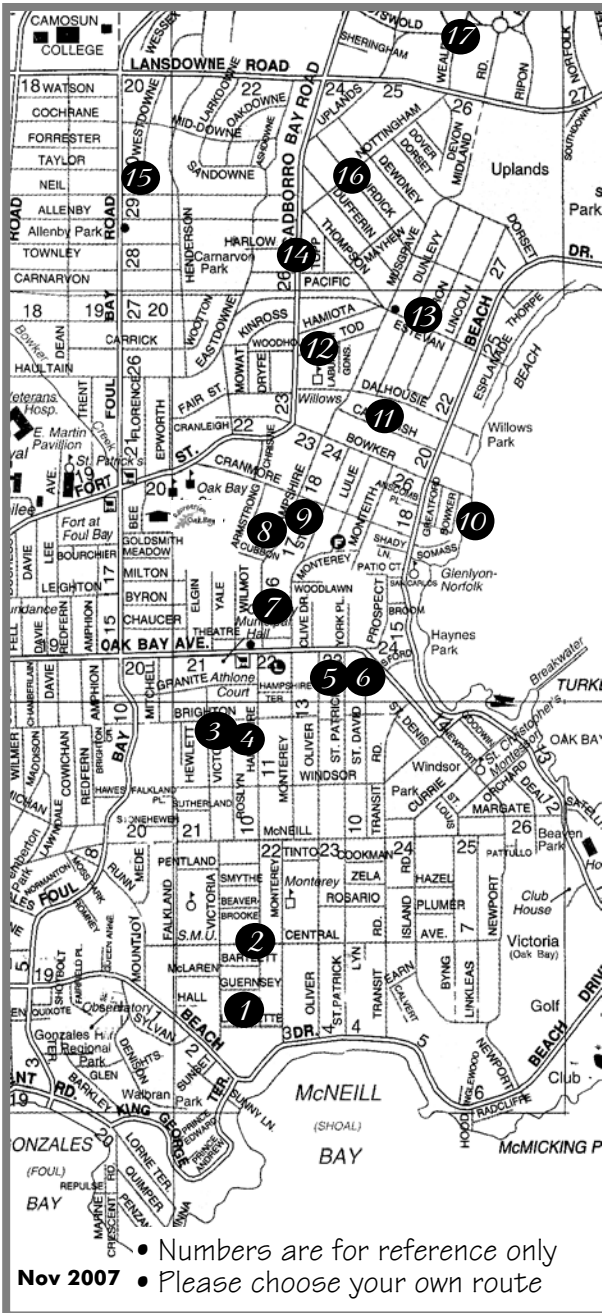

Refreshments will be served.



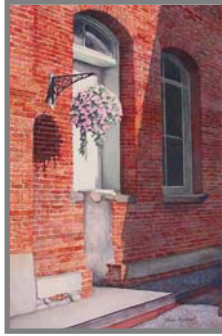
